PATHWAYS TO CHANGE

A cognitive skills program designed to positively affect offender thinking, decision making and behavior.

DRUG COURT

A highly intensive collaboration between the court, treatment providers, the offender and Probation and Parole designed to intervene at the earliest stage possible during the offender's involvement in the criminal justice system. There are active Drug Court programs in the Ozark, Douglas, Wright and Texas Counties.

OFFENDERS OFFERING ALTERNATIVES

An inmate program at certain DOC facilities for at risk youthful offenders under field supervision.
