Impact of Crime on Victims - ICVC:

ICVC is a group which provides information to offenders on how crime impacts victims as well as families and the community. Hours (specific time and dates are set). Contact supervising officer.

Offenders Offering Alternatives: *An educational session and guided tour of a correctional facility conducted by inmates. Emphasis is on the loss of freedom along with group discussion on lifestyle, choices, and alternatives to criminal behavior. Contact supervising officer.*

Pathways to Change: *A cognitive development program designed to help offenders change their behavior by offering insight into the decision making process. It increases cognitive skills through value based lesson plans.*
