

DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Lafayette and Ray Counties

Depending on an offender's specific need, an officer may make a referral to one of the following treatment related programs offered through the District 32 office (note: other resources outside the office are also available).

Intake Group: This program is conducted on the last Monday of each month at 6:30pm at the District Office. There is no fee. Group is mandatory for anyone on supervision residing in Lafayette or Ray County. You will be given an opportunity to ask questions regarding your supervision and the requirements of such.

Offenders Offering Alternatives: Designed for male/female offenders to spend a day in a DOC facility. Tours are prearranged and your officer will provide specific information for the next available date. The meeting location for each tour is at the Warrensburg District Office at 7:00am on the specified date. **YOU MUST ARRANGE YOUR OWN TRANSPORTATION.**

Victim Impact Panel: This program is designed to expose offenders to a panel of speakers relating for a variety of offenses. The cost is \$35.00 (money order made payable to Missouri River Valley CAB). Panels are conducted every month at the Higginsville Community Center, 801 W. 29th Street, Higginsville, MO 64037.

S.T.O.P. (Sanction, Treatment, Opportunity, Progress): An 18 month intensive drug treatment program for offenders who have an alcohol and/or drug related offense. Offenders are placed in this program after they are screened by the prosecutor and probation and parole. Offenders are referred to this program, by the Prosecutor, the defense attorney or a probation officer. This program includes but is not limited to, group meetings, individual meetings with a counselor, frequent random UA drops, NA/AA meetings, meetings with the Probation Officer and a monthly Court appearance. A \$500.00 fee is paid and 100 hours of community service are performed.

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Pathways Community Behavior Services

Provides substance abuse, alcohol, anger control and mental health counseling. Offers both inpatient and outpatient treatment services. Central States Mental Health Consultants, Inc. Provides substance abuse, anger management, domestic violence, driver improvement, shoplifting, MIP and SATOP classes. Rodgers-Lafayette 4 Life Center: Provides counseling for physical and mental health needs. Individual and family counseling are available. A 26-week Batterer's Intervention Program is available, upon referral. The Office is located at 811-A S. 13 Highway, Lexington, MO 64067 (660)259-3823

Missouri Career Center: Provides offenders with help in education, vocational rehabilitation and employment. Offers classes for education and job skills through the Division of Workforce Development. The center has services to individuals with disabilities through Vocational Rehabilitation. The office is located at 802 State Route 13, Lexington, MO 64067. (660)259-4671

Parents Fair Share: This program offers aid to offenders who have nonsupport issues. The program offers similar services as the career center, however, is directed at those with child support issues. Offenders must meet certain qualifications to participate in this program. Appointments can be made through the career center.
