## **District Programs**

District 4R is comprised entirely of specialty programming unique to the Kansas City area.

The Kansas City Community Center Residential Facility is a contracted program that houses 150 men and women. Clients receive case management services, shelter, meals and are referred to local employment agencies and various treatment programs. Clients work with their probation/parole officer and assigned case manager to develop home plans in the community.

The Treatment Resources Encouraging New Directions (TREND) program is also a contracted program that houses 56 men. This program is six months in duration and is specifically designed to prevent men from ever going to prison. The first two phases are residential and provide substance abuse classes, individual counseling, case management services, employment skills development and GED programming. The last phase focuses on reintegration into a community based home plan. Specific substance abuse counselors and case managers are assigned to each client in this program.

## **District Programs con't**

The Alt Care Program is an intensive level outpatient substance abuse program for females. Alt Care provides from four to thirty-five hours of treatment per week, with individual and group counseling, case management services, a registered nurse on site at all times, educational, child care services, family therapy and mental health services as well as access to inpatient treatment and transportation and housing assistance if necessary. A specific substance abuse counselor and community support worker is assigned to each client in this program.

The Sentencing Assessment Unit for Jackson County is assigned to District 4R. This unit completes all Sentencing Assessment Reports (SAR) for the Jackson County courts and for those offenders living in Jackson County with charges pending elsewhere in the state.

The Regional Minimum Supervision Unit for Jackson County is also assigned to District 4R. This unit supervises those clients that report monthly via phone.

The Regional Out of District caseload for Jackson County is also managed at the District 4R office.

## **Payment Information**

### **Restitution**

Payment remittance is based on individual court order and may be made to an individual or through a private collection agency.

### **Court Costs**

Jackson County probation cases make court cost payments to the Department of Criminal Records located at 1315 Locust, Kansas City, MO 64106. Please note that after six months, outstanding court cost obligations are normally routed through a collection agency.

### **Child Support**

Where child support payments are sent varies widely. Please contact your supervising probation/parole officer for information specific to your case.
